REFUND POLICY

A student must notify Ignite Bible College Dean of Students of their intentions to withdraw. The withdrawal date is the date the notification is received by IB&S in writing; and this date will be used in calculating the amount of tuition refund.

The application fee is not refundable.

Tuition Paid in Full

Students who officially withdraw may be granted a refund on the following schedule:

Within 30 days from date of enrollment/payment	50% of Advance Payment
Within 45 days from date of enrollment/payment	30% of Advance Payment
Within 90 days from date of enrollment/payment	0%
